As a flight officer, he saw action on bombing missions from Alaska and the Aleutians. After his return to the States, he commanded the 42nd Bomb Group Detachment.

On January 29, 1943, Lawrence lost his life in an effort to keep his B-25 Bomber in flight when its control surfaces had become ice-covered. Because one crew member did not jump with the five who parachuted to safety, Captain Wagner remained with his bomber. He was posthumously awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross for his last actions.
