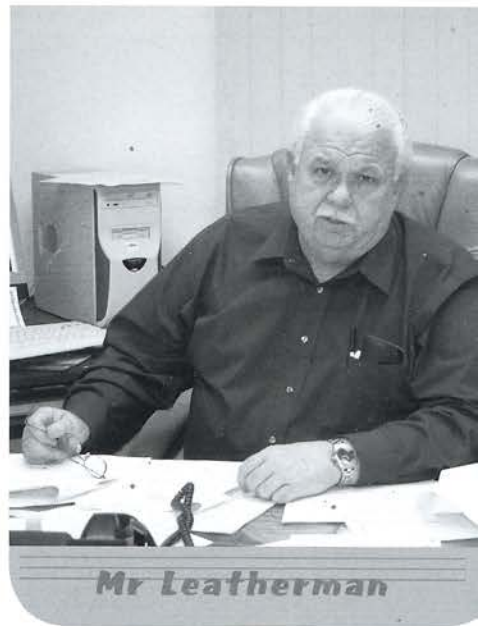


# curtain call
