Genealogy - marriage lookups in Doniphan County

Hi Tina,

I just spoke with you by phone, and am requesting two marriage lookups in the early Doniphan County Marriage books.

I am looking for a marriage for Jonathon B. Lheureux, who married a Mary/Marie Marcot, likely around 1857 or 1858. In the 1860 census, John and Mary were enumerated in Marion Township, Doniphan, Kansas.

And also a marriage for a Florant Courtin to a Frances Marcot. Courtin married Frances in 1862 according to his obituary. His obituary mentions that he married a Mrs. Frances Maucut.

Courtin had lived around Severance since moving there around 1858. His first wife, Barbara, died about 1860. It has just occurred to me to also ask if you have any early death records that might reflect any information on this death, or on the death of Jonathan Lheureux' first wife, as he was also a widower? I do not know her first name at this time.

I am not sure of the spellings of the last names, but would be phonetically similar. I would appreciate any information that might be in your files.


Dear Kate.

The only listings I found in the Doniphan County marriage book were Clements Madoulet who married Mary Marcott 16 Aug. 1859. I could find no listings for any Lheureux. Florant Courtin married Frances McDoobe on the 26 May 1862. I checked the Doniphan County cemetery listings for Jonathan Lheureux with no luck also. If you would like to try looking for him the cemetery book for Doniphan County is on the internet.
