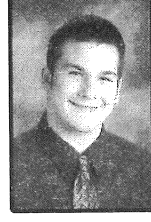

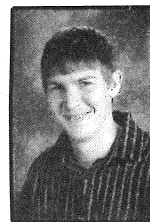

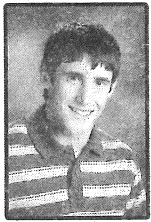

"Our lives are before us. . ." 18 of the 34 students in the graduating class at Doniphan West plan to continue their education at Highland Community College. Some of the classes' favorite memories include winning class of the year as sophomores, winning the Homecoming float contest twice, and participating in the Winter Royalty and Homecoming events. HCC 2009 Commencement Tuesday, May 19

Plans have been finalized for the 2009 commencement exercises at Highland Community College. The 2009 commencement will again be held outdoors on Tuesday evening, May 19, at 7:00 pm on Kessinger Field on the HCC campus. Over 150 graduates are scheduled to hear Kansas Public Radio personality Laura Lorson, who will be the guest speaker. Lorson hosts and produces the local *All Things Considered* for Kansas Public Radio. Commencement exercises will begin with the traditional march across the campus of the HCC faculty and graduating students into the stadium, led by the Tullintrain Pipe Band bagpipe troupe. A commencement meal starting at 5:30 am will be available from Great Western Dining Services, served in the HCC Cafeteria with seating available on the front lawn. Great Western will also host a reception on the lawn following the commencement exercises.


