FRANCIS BARRY, 73

Francis (Frank) Barry, 73, died Sunday morning at his farm home on Rt. 2. Born at Atlantic, Ia., Mr. Barry had been a resident of the Wathena community since 1950, moving here from St. Jo.

Mr. Barry was a veteran of World War I, having served with the army. A retired farmer, he was a member of the Wathena American Legion post.

He is survived by his wife, Georgia of the home and one foster daughter, Mrs. Richard Eggert of Duluth, Minn., and a foster son, Norman Siverson of Kansas City, Mo. A son was killed while serving overseas during World War II and a daughter died in infancy.
