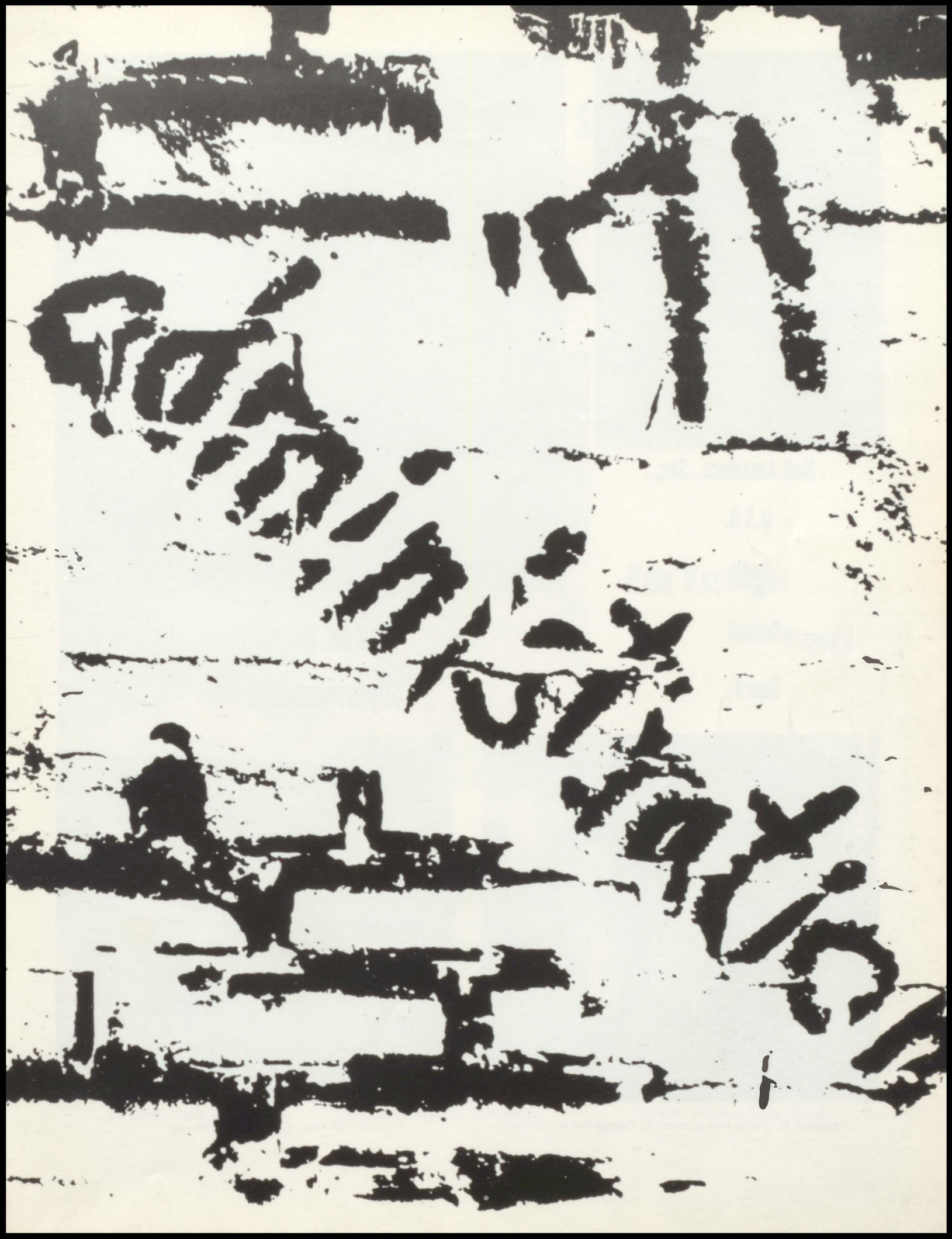
The school year 1970-71 brought the students of Troy High through a period of revival. It was a year in which the millstone of apathy was thrown off, and the students came to the surface revived.

The fuller appreciation of all these things, however, is perhaps the most distinctive feature of any renaissance.

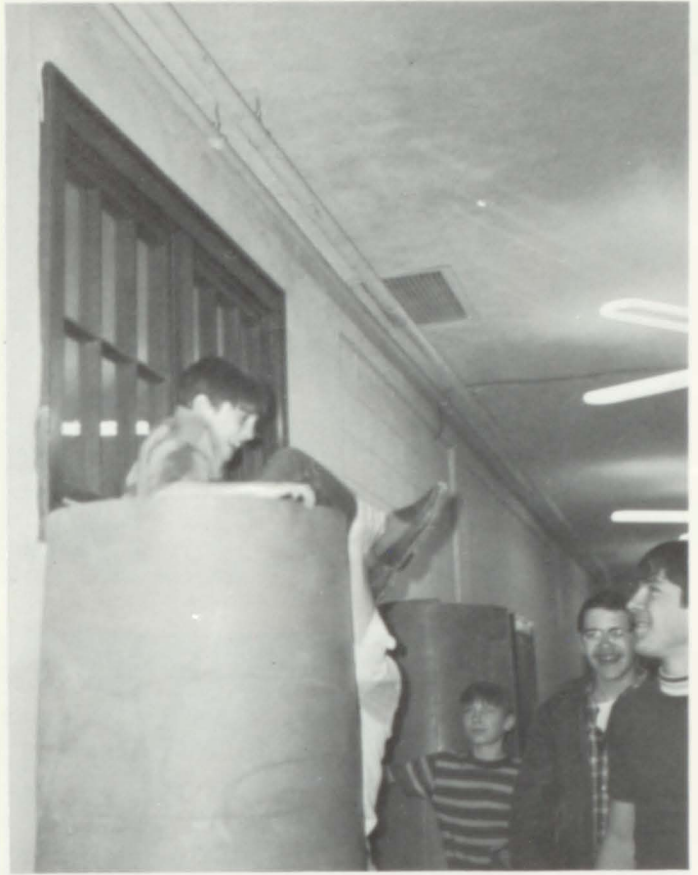
The staff of the TROJAN has chosen the word RENAISSANCE for its theme.

The students of Troy High School have rediscovered the spirit of the early 1960's.

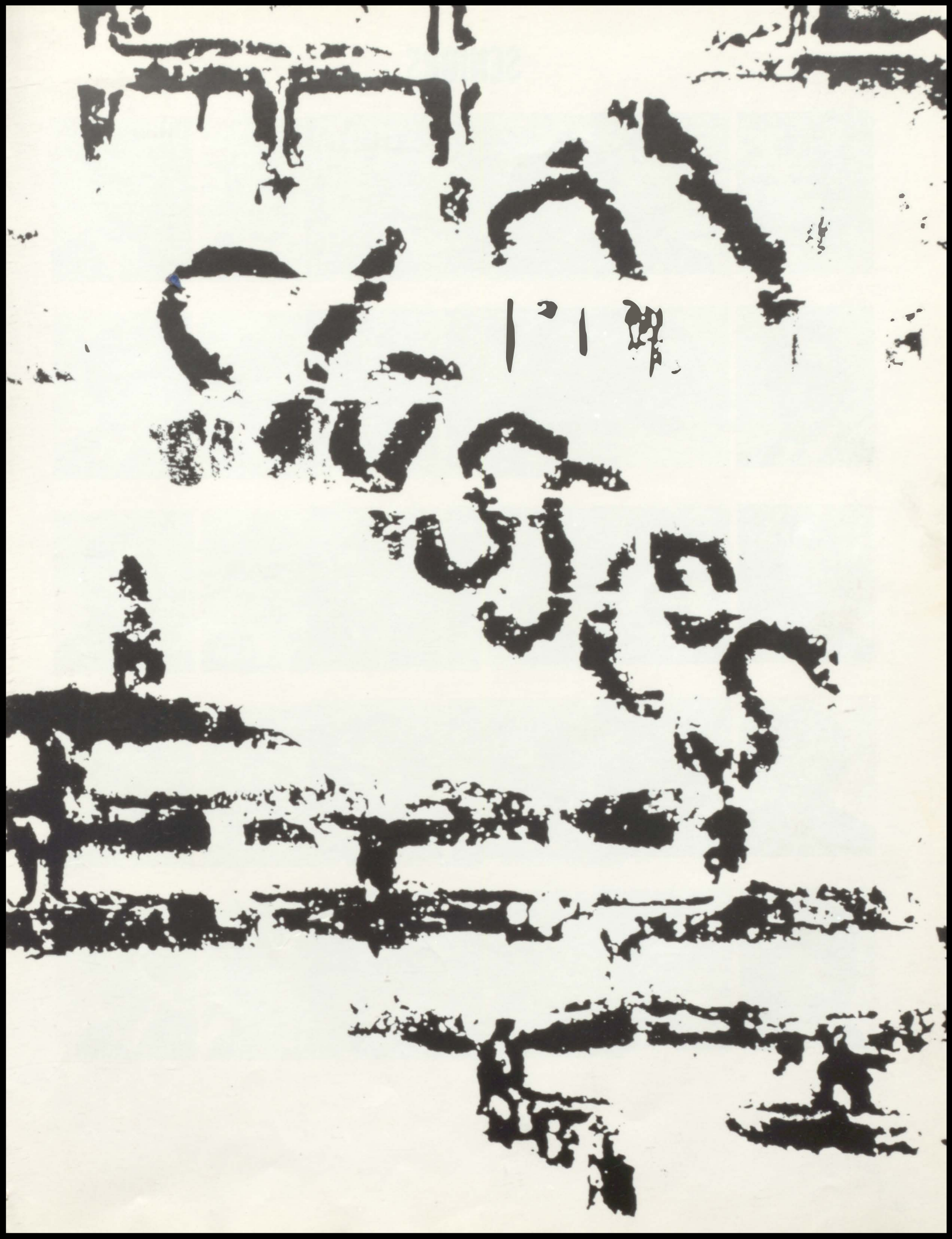




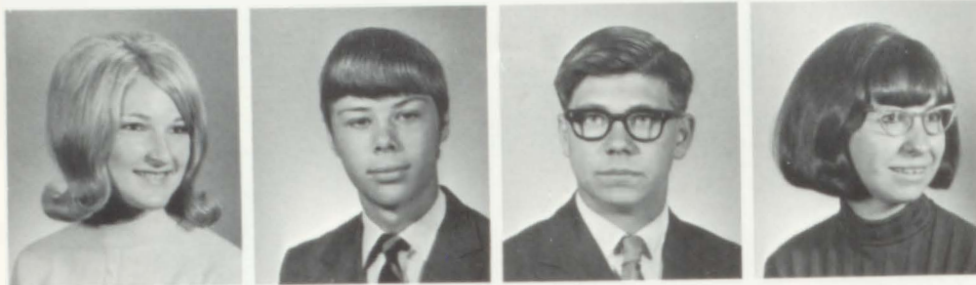








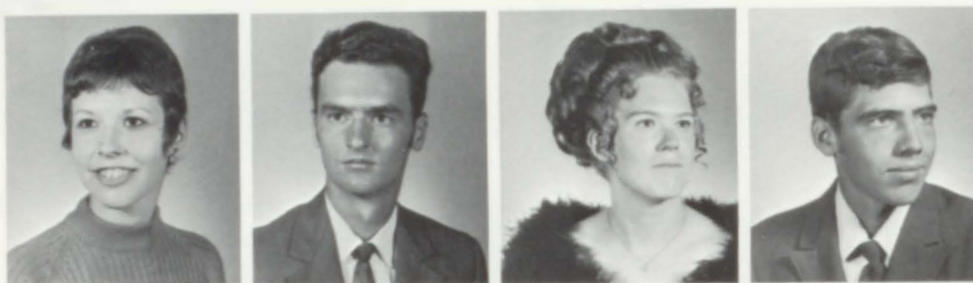

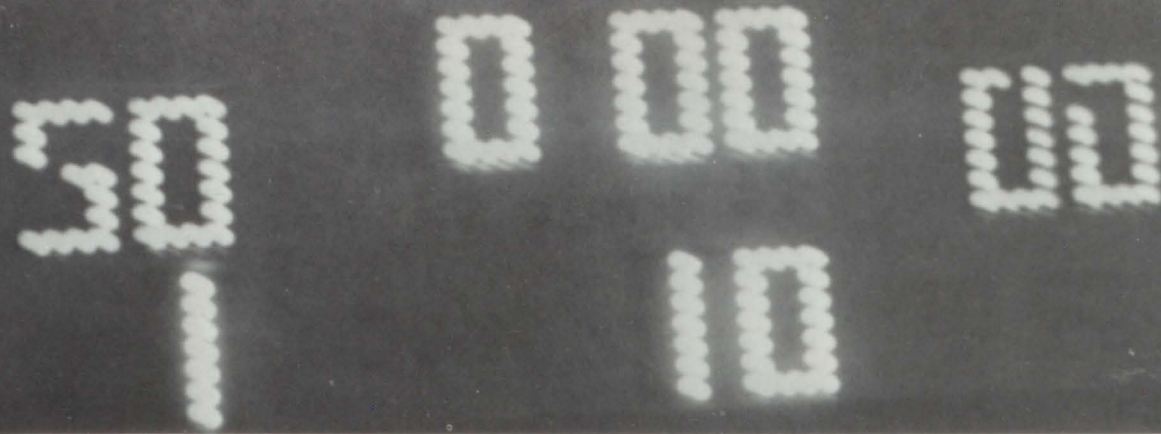












## Homecoming - 1970

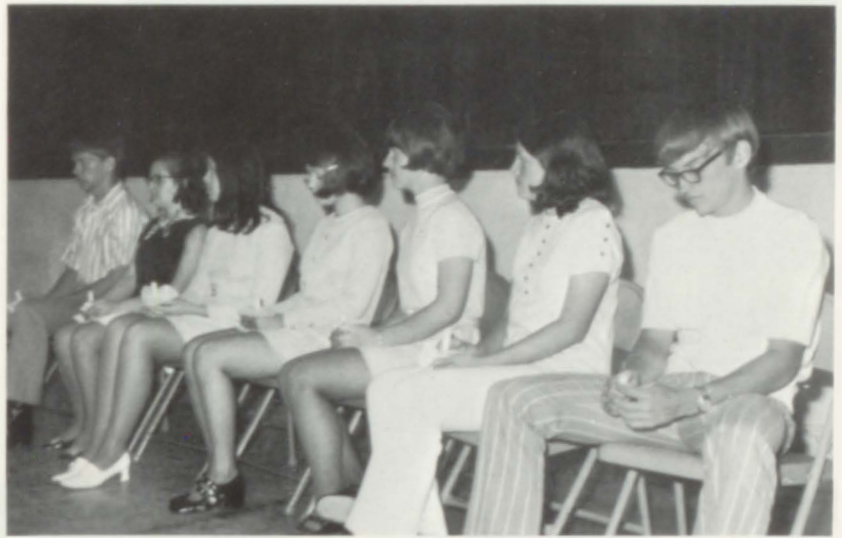

Following commencement a dance was held in the armory honoring the graduates. The dance was sponsored by the Ladies Auxiliary of Troy.

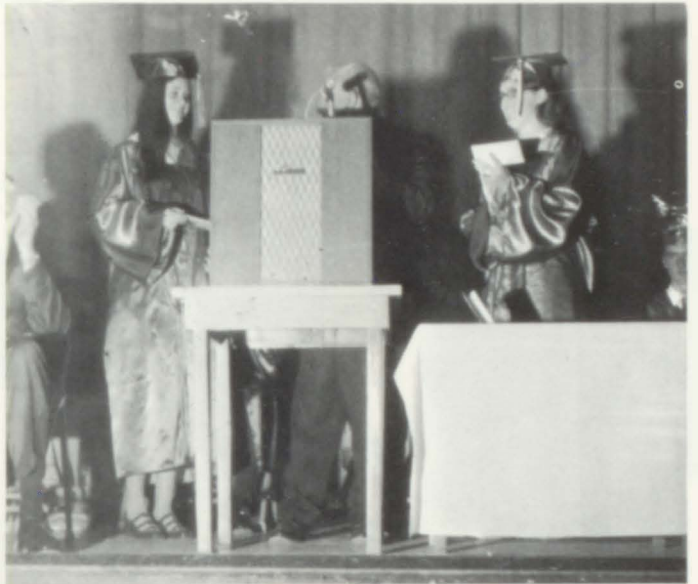
